Advanced Materials Business of Aditya Birla Group, a global epoxy and coatings manufacturer recognizes that effective Supply Chain is key to minimizing the health, safety and environmental impacts of our operations. Our business is spread across different geographies and is part of respective legal entities.

Applicability: This Policy shall apply to all Units of ABG Advanced Materials Business and shall be adopted by all sites and offices owned, controlled, and managed by ABG Advanced Materials.

Oversight: The Business CEO signing this Policy is accountable for the Policy and Country wise Unit Heads are responsible for implementing the policy at their respective sites. Country entities are disclosing their policies and this policy is in harmony with our Country wise entity policies.

Every Advanced Materials Business unit shall endeavor to:

- Ensure compliance with local, national, and international legislation within the supply chain, conformance to the ABG Sustainability Framework requirements.
- Create a supply chain that is resilient and viable amidst the risks and opportunities that may arise from geopolitical, external, legal, technical, environmental and societal megatrends, as part of our business futureproofing program.
- Build capabilities within the supply chain to create best-in-class supply chain solutions.
- To ensure transparency regarding the origin of goods and their environmental impact.
- Promote resource conservation, the use of alternative materials and renewable energy, water stewardship, safety, health, respect for human rights and the elimination of child and forced labor across the supply chain.
- Select suppliers through a competitive and transparent process including requests for proposals (RFPs),
 requests for quotations (RFQs) or other appropriate methods.
- Regularly monitor supplier performance to ensure compliance with sustainable practices, contractual terms, quality standards, and delivery schedules.
