- To establish goals, metrics and responsibility matrix for all parties involved in multimodal transportation

- Conduct Journey risk assessments, prepare emergency plans for transportation related emergencies and conduct mock drills to increase preparedness of our teams to ensure transport safety
- Prioritise initiatives aimed at continual improvement of multimodal transportation, including pollution reduction and prevention, driver safety and wellbeing, emissions and energy conservation, vehicle tracking and digital aids to ensure our operations are sustainable
- Align our supply chain across businesses to adopt ABG Transportation policy while at the same time enhancing awareness of transportation safety and efficiency through participation and consultation
- Monitor, measure, and report the progress on the performance of transportation including safety indicators, service indicators and efficiencies to relevant stakeholders.
- Set up feedback mechanisms to receive inputs to improvement of the system
- Undertake internal and third-party audits at regular intervals to assess transportation performance and conduct due diligence during mergers and acquisitions and in new projects
